2. Select a session that you want to join in the left pane. The virtual space for that session will be displayed.

 - b. If the selected session is yet to begin, the session details will be displayed in the right pane of the page.
3. Optional: Click the **Go to All Tracks** link to view other tracks in order to join a different session in the event.
4. To participate in the session:

 - b. Click the **Questions** tab to pose a question for the speaker; the host will read them on your behalf.

Adapt, Adopt, Thrive...or Not, Tales from the Trenches: A Peer-to-Peer Roundtable Discussion

The pandemic disrupted business continuity and project priorities with long-term impacts on our ways of working. Many organizations quickly assembled a current state of operations that was ad-hoc and temporary. And yet we are still only halfway through our change journey with a return to a "new normal" at some point. And as the market heats up and the complexity of doing business continues to increase, individuals and organizations are seeking insights that might help them simplify things. How can we proactively prepare our teams to transition to a future state when there are so many unknowns?
