

# PDD – Program Manager – Content Team

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Engage keynote and track speakers, set speaker schedules, coordinate the speaker dinner (budget permitting).

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

Activities include but are not limited to:

- Identify and select the keynote speaker
- Coordinate logistics (with Facilities) for the keynote speaker
- Put out the "Call for Speakers"
- Align the theme with speakers
- Manage speaker contracts (to be signed by the PMINYC VP and the speakers)
- Manage speaker budgets within guidelines
- Coordinate the speaker dinner (when budget permits)
- Coordinate speaker logistics
- Manage speaker material, as needed
- Prepare and submit budget (if any) to Leadership
- Coordinate speaker reimbursements and honorariums
- Create / update role descriptions for the Content Team roles and recruit volunteers as needed

In addition to executing the above goals and activities, work with the VP of Professional Development to vet instructors and programs that are being considered by the Education Team for the chapter.
